

Expulsions of students with disability receiving 'substantial' or 'extensive' levels of adjustment in the NCCD in 2023

Students with a NCCD categorisation of 'substantial' or 'extensive'

As of 2022, the department has adopted the Nationally Consistent <u>Collection of Data on School Students with Disability</u> (NCCD) as the measure for students with disability in its expulsion data, replacing students receiving funding under the Program for Students with Disabilities (PSD). Data provided comprises students receiving 'substantial' or 'extensive' evels of adjustments to support their schooling, which is a larger subset of students than previously reported on.
