Art Gallery of Ballarat	AGB Art Connect - a visual arts program designed to develop improved knowledge and practical skills in a range of areas across the F-10 visual art curriculum, as well as tailored programs for VCE Art and Studio Art students, drawing on the extensive Art Gallery of Ballarat collection.
Australian Centre for Contemporary Art	Contemporary Art Now: Student Program (CAN) - an inquiry-based visual arts learning program for F-10 & VCE designed to extend students' classroom learning and support the creative and critical thinking capacities of students through exploration, discussion and creating of contemporary artworks.
Centre for Contemporary Photography	Fitzroy Art Spaces Tour (FAST) is an on site (and online) education program for VCE Studio Arts giving students the opportunity to explore on site the contemporary art industry within the local art precinct of Fitzroy.
Creative Victoria	Creative Learning Partnerships (CLP) - a program to enable creative professionals or creative organisations to partner and collaboratively design a unique, needs-based, in-situ creative residency project with students, teachers, and a school community.
Footscray Community Arts Centre	Regenerate: Learning First Nations Perspectives - This program will connect students from Melbourne's West with local Indigenous leaders and their sustainable arts practices, enabling students to develop deep, practical knowledge of living Indigenous arts and culture.
Gertrude Contemporary	ARTNOW Student Learning at Gertrude - through contemporary art exhibitions and connections with visual artists online and in their studios, this program gives VCE Studio Arts students a unique insight into how contemporary art is presented and produced in a professional work practice.
Gippsland Art Gallery	Gippsland Art Gallery Education Program - a program using the Gallery's collection and exhibitions to build students' skills in art, craft and design techniques and processes, as well as teaching students to develop ideas and express these ideas visually.
Heide Museum of Modern Art	Connect and Create at Heide - Programs connecting students with artworks and ideas as well as hands on practical art workshops that extend and complement classroom learning through accessible visual art and cultural experiences.
Horsham Town Hall	Spark Arts Engagement Program - A program delivered across a range of venues in Horsham designed to provide meaningful, creative, hands-on learning opportunities. The program will increase students' enthusiasm for the arts, broaden experiences and bolster educational links for teachers to extend and enliven the delivery of mainstream classroom curriculum.
Kaiela Arts Shepparton	Galnyatj - an Aboriginal art program designed to develop students' knowledge of First Nations art and encourage new perspectives about Australian history and environment as expressed and presented by Aboriginal artists through their art, writing and ideas.
National Gallery of Victoria	Using the rich cultural treasures of the National Gallery of Victoria and the Gallery's annual exhibition program of Australian and international art and design as a starting point, NGV Learn offers a wide range of cross-curricular creative learning programs and resources designed to inspire, enable and empower F-12 students and teachers across Victoria. Onsite programs for students include educator-led one or two hour workshops and full day educator-led programs including floortalks and discussions in gallery spaces, lectures and hands-on workshops in studio spaces. The programs also include self-guided visits (including supporting resources) and online programs for students. NGV Learn curriculum aligned learning resources (including online resources) provide students and teachers with opportunities to deepen their engagement and learning with the NGV Collection and exhibitions. Online learning resources help extend the reach of NGV Learn to teachers and students who may not be able to visit the Gallery due to distance or other circumstances.
Regional Arts Victoria	The Arts & Education program - a program designed to encourage students' participation in the arts, particularly in rural and regional areas, through performances, workshops and immersive creative learning experiences spanning across various artforms.
Shepparton Art Museum	SAM studios - an after-school program to extend arts learning in the classroom, offering art focused mentoring and artist led workshops to senior students from the Goulburn Valley.
Visual Communication Victoria.	Typography, Inspiration and Design - A program to inform and inspire students of design and provide contemporary design resources for students studying Visual Communication Design in years 7--12.
Warrnambool Art Gallery	Explore, Learn, Create - a program to expand classroom options and provide cross-curriculum learning opportunities for students at all levels to inspire and engage; whilst promoting equity, diversity, inclusion and access through exposure to both the permanent collection and temporary exhibitions.
Western Edge Youth Arts	WEYA Artists in Schools Program - a creative workshop program that builds student engagement and confidence in learning, and fosters pride among the school community. Includes 15-week residencies culminating in community performances and discrete in-syllabus workshops.

Arts Centre Melbourne	Performing Arts Extending Student Learning program - through attending performances and post-performance panel discussions, workshops and extended learning experiences at the Arts Centre, students will develop skills in critical and creative thinking, developing ideas through the Arts and interpreting works across Music and Drama.
Back to Back Theatre Inc.	Inclusive Arts Practice for Schools program - Through artist residencies at secondary schools in the Geelong area, Back to Back will lead a series of inclusive workshops, incursions and excursions with particular emphasis on students and artists with a disability.
Geelong Arts Centre	Empowering Voices through the Arts - Through a series of curriculum aligned workshops, incursions and webinars exploring themes of immigration and leadership this program will utilise drama techniques to enhance confidence, develop student agency and amplify voices.

Melbourne Chamber Orchestra	Encounter the Orchestra! - a structured in-person event with an orchestra, giving primary school students opportunities to connect with, appreciate and create music, and form more complex ideas about music across cultures, places and times. Detailed resources for teachers will connect students to the experience and create strong curriculum-based outcomes.
Melbourne Recital Centre	Making Waves - A program for 'Music Styles and Composition' students including mentoring and workshops, culminating in a professional concert experience including a recording presentation of student compositions.
Melbourne Youth Orchestras	MYO Ensemble Program - extending student learning by bringing young musicians together to rehearse, perform and explore ensemble music in string orchestras, symphony orchestras, symphonic bands and other instrumental ensembles.
Musica Viva	MVIS Student Music program - music education experiences and resources designed to increase understanding of musical concepts, enhance critical and creative thinking, and showcase the traditions and language of fellow students for regional and metropolitan primary school students.
Speak Percussion	Sounds Unheard - a program of inspiring music education activities from Speak Percussion, designed to expand Victorian secondary students' knowledge and creativity through innovative approaches to music making.
Victorian Opera	Access All Areas: Livestream Program - a program to deliver equal access to the performing arts to students across Victoria, through four streamed interactive behind-the-scenes workshops and an opera performance in-theatre/streamed to schools and cinemas.

Kids Thrive	Bass Coast Kids Thrive - a virtual co-teaching model of the Kids as Catalysts program in schools across Bass Coast. A curriculum-aligned, evidence-based program that develops student voice, agency and leadership, engagement, educational outcomes and resilience through meaningful social action. The program will include a suite of online student/teacher resources to assist teachers to support their students' voice and leadership.
Western Chances	Western Chances Links Program - providing Western Chances secondary school scholarships recipients with high value academic, personal and professional opportunities delivered outside the school environment to broaden knowledge/skills, foster leadership and boost confidence.

Beechworth Historical Precinct	Encounters, Our History, Your History - Educator led tours of the Burke Museum to explore the history of Beechworth, colonialism and repatriation, student-led, guided re-enactments of courthouse trials and outdoor tours of the precinct.
History Council of Victoria Incorporated	HCV History Roadshow - a series of curriculum-specific presentations tailored to the needs of rural and regional VCE history students, helping students consider the impact history can have on their future careers, and building life-long enthusiasm for the study of history.
Islamic Museum of Australia	Makassans, Cameleers and Pearl Divers - A program exploring early Muslim migration including the connected history between Australia's First Nations Peoples and Muslim migrants dating back to the early 1700s, contributing to students' understanding of the value of cultural diversity including the contribution of migrants. .
Melbourne Holocaust Museum	Life lessons from the Holocaust- A Holocaust education program designed to extend students learning of the challenges of social isolation, disengagement with education and the rise of racism and prejudice through misinformation.
Eureka Centre Ballarat	Eureka Education Online - A new program specifically designed for online delivery. Pre-and-post activity resources and a live workshop delivered remotely will bring the Eureka Centre Ballarat into Victorian classrooms.

Melbourne Writers Festival	MWF Schools' Program - through presentations and workshops from the world's best writers as part of a major cultural festival, students are exposed to an environment where reading, writing and thinking, and talking about reading and writing and thinking is normal and celebrated.

La Trobe University - In2Science	In2science - A peer mentoring program to increase student engagement in maths and science. University STEM student volunteer mentors connect the STEM curriculum to everyday life and build students' confidence in their abilities to approach challenging tasks and problems, relating schoolwork to real-world examples.
Mathematical Association of Victoria	Mathematics Camp High Potential Students - a program to engage students of high mathematics interest and potential through enrichment experiences beyond the classroom to develop student capabilities and confidence in STEM subjects.
