HOLD AN EDUCATION WEEK ACTIVITY AT SCHOOL

Below are some ideas of activities related to the 'Celebrating the arts' theme to help guide your plans for Education Week. Activities can be as large or as small as you like.

- hold an open day/school tours with a special focus on student achievement in arts
- display artworks by students in an exhibition for the community
- hold an "Open Mic" session for students to share their favourite poetry or artistic hobby
- dance, music and drama performances for the community
- hold an outdoor painting class
- hold a creative writing competition
- create a school mural involving all year groups
- hold special lessons in animation, dance or photography
- hold music therapy and art therapy sessions
- create an school arts challenge (students vs. teachers)
- create an arts newsletter with submissions by students to be sent home
- invite local artists into school to hold a workshop and speak about their careers
- incorporate the arts into core subjects such as English, science and mathematics
