An all round performer and educator, Mark's career, since his graduation from Rusden State College, has taken him through many diverse areas of performance and teaching.

Mark has worked in television as an actor and a dancer, in shows that range from *The Sullivans* to *The Don Lane Show* and *The Logies*. His theatre credits include Sydney Theatre Company's *Chicago*, The Australian Opera Company's *Carmen* and The Really Useful Company's *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*.

His teaching credits include Rusden State College, Box Hill TAFE and Dance Factory.

He is a woodwind examiner for both the Australian Music Examination Board and the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority.

As Musical Director for JOINING the CHORUS, Kirk was Musical Director for *Oklahoma* at Her Majesty's Theatre in 2006 the Opening and Closing Ceremonies of the *Pacific Schools Games* in 2005 and the *2003 State Schools Spectacular — Retrospect*. Kirk has musically directed many award winning productions including *Mack & Mabel, Candide, Oklahoma, La Cage Aux Folles, On The Twentieth Century, Follies, City of Angels, West Side Story* and *Barnum*. In 2007 Kirk was the Musical Director for the Twelfth Night Theatre, Brisbane's tribute production of *Carousel*.

Kirk has received four Music Theatre Guild Awards for Best Musical Director from the Musical Theatre Guild of Victoria.

Isaac was costume designer for *As You Like It* for the 2008 season of Shakespeare in the Park for Deckchair Theatre and Kings Park Botanic Garden, *Memmie LeBlanc* at Deckchair Theatre for the Adelaide Fringe Festival, *Dash, Powder Monkey* and *KissXX* for STEPS Youth Dance Company. He has worked on *Irene in Concert* starring Debbie Reynolds, and *The Drovers Wife* for Steamworks Productions.

He has also created costumes for the 2007 and 2008 Perth Wildflower Festivals, and Ultimate Kylie, who starred in the 2008 season of Australia's Got Talent.

An expert in the Kodaly Method of music education, Jan is frequently called upon to adjudicate choir competitions and make presentations at teacher conferences. Jan's success in creating high-standard choirs comes from the belief that excellence is always the goal and that given proper training, children are capable of very high standards of musicianship.

As well as producing the State Schools Spectacular and the JtC musical, the JOINING the CHORUS program runs the following performance ensembles:

- JtC Dancers (Melbourne, Warragul and Geelong)


Students with an aptitude and talent for performance attend weekly rehearsals to receive tuition and direction from Victoria's leading performing arts teachers, working on repertoire that is performed, on behalf of the Department, in some of Melbourne's great venues, including the Regent Theatre, Her Majesty's Theatre, the Palladium Ballroom, the National Gallery and the MCG.

To be eligible students must be attending a Victorian government school.

Dance auditions are held in groups of approximately 10-20 and singing and band members' auditions are solo.

Fees for ensemble membership are only \$200 per year (EMA students \$100). The fee covers all tuition, administration, transport to performances when required and costumes.
