David Bell - Director

David began his career as a theatre designer, receiving the prestigious Loudon Sainthill Scholarship for Australian Stage Design in 1984, followed by a Director's Development Grant from the Australia Council in 1988. He has since directed award-winning plays, dance, circus and opera all over Australia, as well as creating original theatre works. His productions have toured internationally and have been broadcast on television.

In 2000 he received a Sir Winston Churchill Memorial Fellowship to investigate contemporary theatre and large-scale events in Singapore, New York and Paris. He recently completed a Graduate Diploma of Film and Television at the Victorian College of the Arts.

Kirk Skinner - Music Director

Kirk studied at the Victorian College of Arts and holds graduate and postgraduate qualifications in music. He is a woodwind examiner for both the Australian Music Examination Board and the Victorian Curriculum Assessment Authority.

Kirk has musically directed many award-winning productions, including *Mack & Mabel, La Cage Aux Folles, City of Angels* and *Barnum.* He has also conducted for the touring productions of *Cats* and *Les Miserables*, and has musically directed the three *One Night Stand With...* concerts presented by the Victorian AIDS Council. He has also been honoured by the Music Theatre Guild of Victoria with four Best Musical Director awards.

Mark Laguerre - Dance Director



Christina Smith - Set and Prop Designer



Told in song, music and dance, 'Retrospect' features a 1547 strong choir, 63 musicians and more than 1300 dancers. Top this off with 31 'stars' of tomorrow who are the featured vocalists of this year's show and you've got a wonderful, blockbuster production that everyone will enjoy.



JtC Singers

JtC Singers comprises 96 students from Years 4 to 12 from Victorian Government schools. It is a prestigious ensemble whose repertoire ranges from Renaissance to contemporary popular music. Formed in 1997, the ensemble enables singers to extend their technical, musical and performance skills. It is directed by Douglas Heywood, OAM, whose professional work has spanned the areas of opera and oratorio, as well as orchestral conducting. These talented choristers perform at state and private functions throughout the year. Rehearsals take place every Saturday of the school term at the JtC Studios. Auditions are open to all Victorian Government school students.

JtC Dancers

JtC Dancers was established in 1995 to promote and encourage dance in Victorian Government Schools. It provides young dancers with the opportunity to work in a professional and highly productive environment. JtC Dancers consists of junior and senior ensembles, with 24 dancers in each. Throughout the year, JtC Dancers present a variety of workshops and performances at state and private functions. Their focus is on modern and contemporary dance. Rehearsals take place every Saturday of the school term at the JtC studios. Auditions are open to all Victorian Government School students.

JtC Regional Ensembles

In 1999, the JtC dance ensembles were established in Bendigo, Ballarat, Leongatha and Geelong. These ensembles were established to give students greater performance and learning opportunities in regional areas. Students attend lessons on a weekly basis within their local area.


Most of these vehicles have been rebuilt by their owners using modern engines and components to improve safety and performance, while retaining the unique features of the original cars.
