Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children aged three and four can access 15 hours per week of free or low-cost kindergarten.

In a kinder program, children use play to build their language skills and learn about numbers and patterns. They also learn how to get along with others, share, listen, and manage their emotions.

Kinder programs have qualified teachers who create culturally safe places for Aboriginal children and families, through including Aboriginal perspectives in the learning program and environment.
