



Kindergarten Parent Opinion Survey 2023

The Kindergarten Parent Opinion Survey is an anonymous annual online survey that invites parents to provide feedback about what's going well at your child's kindergarten, as well as any areas for improvement. The survey includes questions on parent experience and satisfaction with their child's kindergarten program.

When does the survey take place?

The survey will take place from Wednesday 15 November to Friday 8 December 2023.

Why is the survey important?

The results will help your service to provide the best possible kindergarten experience for children and families by understanding what is working well for families and identifying any areas for improvement.

How long does the survey take?

The survey will take a couple of minutes to complete.

Who can participate in the survey?

Parents or guardians of children enrolled in a Three or Four-Year-Old Kindergarten program may complete the survey.

Your participation in the survey helps your service continue to deliver the best possible service for children. The survey is not compulsory, however your participation contributes to improvement in the quality of kindergarten programs.

How is the survey accessed?

Your kindergarten service may have contacted you via email or SMS with a link to complete the survey online.

The survey is carried out online and can be completed by parents on a smartphone, tablet or desktop computer.

Privacy statement

No identifying information of participants is collected in the survey. Participants remain completely anonymous.
