The Victorian Primary School Nursing Program is a free health service offered to students in their first year of school.



The Victorian Primary School Nursing Program can provide advice and support for concerns with your child's:

- general health, wellbeing and development
- hearing and vision
- speech and language development
- behaviour and emotional regulation
- oral health.

An optional School Entrant Health Questionnaire will soon be provided by your child's school. The questionnaire can be completed online or you can request a paper copy. Information you share in the questionnaire is confidential.
