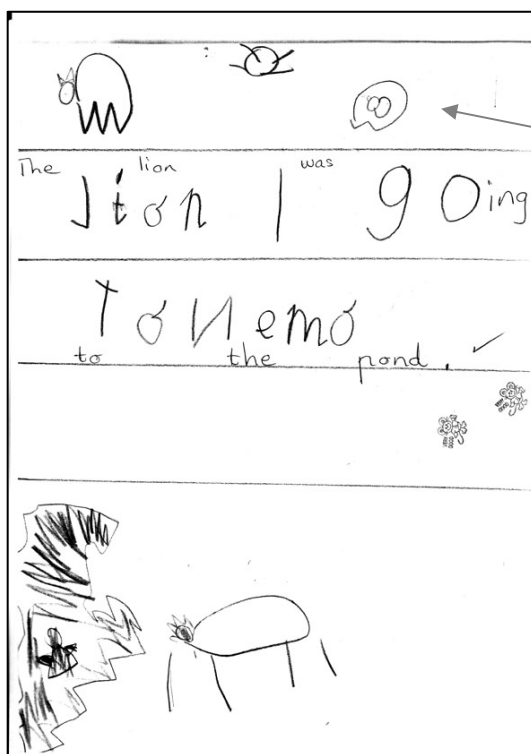

This text is an example of a student at A1 Standard. The student writes a simple text to retell a part of a story. The student writes from left to right and leaves spaces between most of the words. There is evidence of planning for writing and using illustrations to provide more detail. The student copies words and writes some common words correctly although all of the words written do not match what has been dictated to the teacher.
