This text is an example of a student at A2 Standard. The text includes simple past tense and present simple tense and includes one irregular past tense verb (found). Familiar time markers are used to order the sequence of events. The student is able to spell some high frequency words correctly and attempts to spell some unknown words using the sounds he can hear. Full stops are used consistently. The student uses a capital letter for the pronoun 'l', but not to begin sentences.
