This text is an example of a student progressing towards B3. While the text is short and quite simply written, the student uses metaphor to compare a teacher to gardener. He also asks questions to engage the reader. The text is sequenced logically so that the comparison between a teacher and a gardener is clearly developed. Examples of the teacher's corrections and insertions, such as, "What does that mean ing for?" indicate that ESL features are still very evident in this text.
