The task

- uses subject-verb agreement with some accuracy
- copies parts of texts used for reference to include in own writing

Firstly, the special design of opera house is such an important reason to become one of new 7 wonders. It was designed by famous Danish architect - Jørn Utzon. At the first time, his design was beyond the capabilities of engineering of the time. Fortunately, after spending a couple of years to remark the design, he Utzon can could make the distinction distinguishing features for Opera house - the "sails" of the roof. It's such a great idea. Because the opera house is situated on Bennelong Point, which reaches out into the harbour. When the student attempts to express complex thoughts, there is some breakdown in coherency and accuracy, for example 'Furthermore it's the places who many large events happen at', however the intended meaning is still apparent.
