Learn Local providers Access, Choice & Equity Series Virtual Workshops

The 2020 Program has now been adapted in response to COVID-19 to be delivered online.

Through the VET Development Centre (VDC), the Victorian Department of Education and Training (DET) aims to improve the capability and capacity of the pre-accredited VET sector by making a range of professional learning opportunities available to Learn Local providers.

The professional learning opportunities reflect the goal of the **Pre-accredited Quality Framework** to ensure that quality and continuous improvement are embedded throughout all aspects of pre-accredited planning, program design and delivery, including improved learner pathways.

Description:

The **Learn Local providers Access, Choice & Equity Series** virtual workshops have been designed and adapted into a highly interactive virtual workshop for 25 participants.
