

8. Conversation

Chinese, Part 4: Asking about family

This task is to be completed by students in pairs or threes.

Write a script for a conversation in Chinese that could take place in one of the following situations:

- *You are introduced to new classmates at your school.*
- *Your friend asks you questions about your family photos.*
- *Your friend comes to your place for the first time, and you introduce your family.*

Your conversation should include the correct words and phrases for:

1. *greeting and farewelling appropriately*
2. *asking and saying names*
3. *asking and saying age*
4. *introducing family members*
5. *asking and answering simple questions about family members.*

Use good language learning strategies for scripting and rehearsing your conversation:

- *check your notes*
- *check online resources*
- *ask classmates and the teacher for help and feedback*

Rehearse your conversation so that you don't need to read from notes.

Act out your conversation for the rest of the class.
