

Workers' Compensation One-Day Course 2022

All sessions for Term 3 and 4 will be run virtually through Webex meetings, from 10am – 3.00pm with breaks throughout. The completion of this course addresses Return to Work Coordinator competency requirement in Occupational Health and Safety Audits. While this course is not required to be completed annually, it is a great course for anyone new to claims management, anyone who has received a new claim for the first time or as a refresher for experienced staff.

About the program

The session will provide you with the key information needed to proactively manage a Worker's Compensation claim. There are many elements to managing a claim and each role within the scheme plays a different part to achieve an early return to work.

The one-day session will cover:

- introduction to claims, including policy and procedures
- return to work, including identifying suitable duties
- the importance of planning, consulting and communication
- occupational rehabilitation services.

Who can attend

The program is open to Department of Education and Training (Department) employees who have been appointed by Workplace Managers as the Return to Work Coordinators and/or manage workers' compensation claims.
