Use your English-German dictionary, or an online dictionary: <http://dict.leo.org/> to find the following words in German.

Use the dictionary to complete the table.

Your dictionary can be a great help, but only when you use it properly. Remember:

Check the information given as abbreviations. For example: m. = masculine, f. = feminine, nt. = neuter, n. = noun,

vt. = verb, adj. = adjective

Think about whether you are looking up a noun, verb, or adjective and look for the right form of the word.

When you look up a German word for its English translation, you may see several choices. Be careful to choose the meaning you need. Read the whole dictionary entry to make that decision.

Cross-checking the English word to find the German translation sometimes helps you ensure that the word you choose has the right meaning.
