die Verkäuferin	<i>the seller (female)</i>
der Verkäufer	<i>the seller (male)</i>
Guten Tag, kann ich Ihnen helfen?	<i>Hello, can I help you?</i>
Was hätten Sie gerne?	<i>What would you like (to have)</i>
Was möchten Sie gerne?	<i>What would you like?</i>
Ja, bitte?	<i>Yes, please?</i> <i>(implying what would you like?)</i>
Ist das (groß/klein) genug?	<i>Is that (big/small) enough?</i>
